Memory Work:

The Second Commandment and its explanation:

You Shall not take the name of the Lord your God in vain.

What does this mean? We should fear and love God so that we do not curse, swear, use satanic arts, lie, or deceive by his name, but call upon it in every trouble, pray, praise, and give thanks.

The Third Commandment and its explanation:

Remember the Sabbath day by keeping it holy.

What does this mean? We should fear and love God so that we do not despise preaching and his Word, but hold it sacred and gladly hear and learn it.

Memorize the names of the books of the Bible, in order, from Genesis to Malachi (see back side for full list).

The new books learned this week comprise the second half of the Old Testament books of Prophecy.
