The Sixth Commandment and its explanation:

You shall not commit adultery.

What does this mean? We should fear and love God so that we lead a sexually pure and decent life in what we say and do, and husband and wife love and honor each other.

The Seventh Commandment and its explanation:

You shall not steal.

What does this mean? We should fear and love God so that we do not take our neighbor's money or possessions, or get them in any dishonest way, but help him to improve and protect his possessions and income.

The new books learned this week comprise the Pauline Epistles because they were written by Paul. Note that from now on, sections from the Old Testament will be given as extra credit work on all memory quizzes.
